Representation and Accretion

TITLE 05 — SUCCESSION · CHAPTER 02 — INTESTATE SUCCESSION

- 1 Representation occurs when the descendants of a predeceased heir step into the place and degree of that heir and receive the share that the heir would have received.
- 2 Representation operates without limit of degree in the direct descending line.
- 3 Where a co-heir renounces or is unworthy, and representation does not apply, the renounced or forfeited share accretes to the other heirs of the same order in proportion to their shares.
