Acquisition of Property

TITLE 02 — THE SOVEREIGN AND THE CROWN · CHAPTER 02 — SOVEREIGN DOMAIN

- 1 Property lawfully acquired by the State becomes part of the Sovereign Domain and is administered under sovereign authority.
- 2 The State may acquire property by contract, gift, grant, exchange, confiscation or forfeiture as provided by law, succession, or any other lawful means.
- 3 Conditions attached to gifts or grants bind the State only if accepted in public capacity and to the extent consistent with these Fundamental Laws and Principles.
- 4 The acquisition and disposition of State property shall be recorded in the manner prescribed by law, including by registration where applicable.
- 5 Property acquired by an organ or official in the name of the State is deemed to be acquired by the State unless the instrument clearly provides otherwise.
