# Abdication

## TITLE 04 — THE ROYAL HOUSE · CHAPTER 02 — SUCCESSION AND REGENCY

- 1 The Sovereign may abdicate by solemn written instrument.
- 2 The instrument shall be signed by the Sovereign and shall state the effective time of abdication; unless otherwise stated, abdication takes effect upon authentication.
- 3 Abdication shall be authenticated in accordance with [Article 40](#) and published in the Royal Kaharagian Gazette, except where publication would materially endanger the continuity or security of the State, in which case publication may be delayed.
- 4 Upon abdication, succession occurs pursuant to [Article 25](#).
- 5 An abdication once effective is irrevocable unless the instrument expressly provides for revocation within a stated period.
