Publication

TITLE 07 — LEGISLATIVE AUTHORITY · CHAPTER 02 — PROMULGATION AND PUBLICATION

- 1 No Code or Act shall have force unless duly promulgated and published in the Royal Kaharagian Gazette.
- 2 A Sovereign Decree comes into effect from the moment it is signed by the Sovereign, unless a later commencement is stated; it shall be published in the Royal Kaharagian Gazette as soon as practicable.
- 3 Publication shall include the text of the instrument and its commencement; unless otherwise stated, an instrument other than a Sovereign Decree takes effect upon publication.
- 4 The Sovereign may provide for delayed commencement, staged commencement, or retroactive effect, provided that retroactivity shall be stated expressly.
- 5 Instruments of purely internal administration may be exempted from publication by law or Sovereign Decree, but shall be recorded in official archives.
- 6 The Royal Kaharagian Gazette may be maintained in digital form; its official edition is that designated by the Sovereign.
