# Supremacy

## TITLE 01 — THE STATE AND THE NATION · CHAPTER 03 — SOVEREIGNTY AND SUPREMACY

- 1 These Fundamental Laws and Principles are the supreme source of law within the State and prevail over all subordinate legislation.
- 2 Any Code, Act, Decree, Regulation, or other norm inconsistent with these Fundamental Laws and Principles has no force to the extent of the inconsistency.
- 3 All public authorities shall interpret and apply subordinate law, so far as possible, consistently with these Fundamental Laws and Principles.
- 4 The Sovereign alone may amend these Fundamental Laws and Principles in accordance with Title X.
- 5 The supremacy of these Fundamental Laws and Principles extends to all organs and officials exercising public authority.
