Embodiment of the State

TITLE 02 — THE SOVEREIGN AND THE CROWN · CHAPTER 01 — THE SOVEREIGN AND DELEGATION

- 1 The Sovereign embodies the unity, continuity, dignity, and authority of the State.
- 2 Sovereign authority is vested in the person of the Sovereign and is transmitted through lawful succession in accordance with the Crown.
- 3 Acts performed by the Sovereign in public capacity are acts of State.
- 4 The style, titles, and insignia of the Sovereign are determined by Royal House Law or by Sovereign Decree.
- 5 Public oaths and affirmations shall be sworn to the Crown as provided by law.
